NOTES FOR THE INFORMATION OF APPLICANTS INCLUDING CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT

- 1. This is a new application please read <u>all</u> the notes and complete form in full.
- 2. A passport sized photograph must be attached to the application form as requested.
- 3. All applicants <u>must</u> be registered with the Teaching Council see hereunder.

Teaching Council Registration

It is now mandatory that all those undertaking the position of Oral/Practical Examiner for the 2023 examinations and subsequent years are registered on the Register of Teachers maintained by the Teaching Council in order to comply with The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Act 2012.

What to do if I am registered?

Complete your registration details - registration number, name as it appears on the register and renewal date - on the application form. The SEC will validate the registration details against the register. Please ensure that you complete these details as failure to do so may delay processing your application. If you are registered at the time of applying and are subsequently appointed, it is your responsibility to ensure that your registration does not lapse and that you are registered at the time of the examinations.

What to do if I am <u>not</u> registered?

Complete the application form for the position of Oral/Practical Examiner in the normal way but indicate that you are not registered. Return the form to the SEC in normal way. However, you must also **apply immediately** to the Teaching Council for registration and have the registration details submitted before the appointments are made in 2023.

Important Information about the Registration Process

It is each applicant's own responsibility to ensure that they are on the Register of Teachers and to provide the SEC with their registration number, when requested. The registration process, which includes a process of Garda Vetting, may take 6 -8 weeks once all required documentation has been received. Applicants are advised to apply for registration immediately. Information on the registration process, including details of registration fees, is available on the Teaching Council's website <u>www.teachingcouncil.ie</u>. The State Examinations Commission accepts no liability for teacher registration fees or for any applicant's inability to meet the registration and vetting requirement within the specified timeframe.

- 4. Appointment to the position of Examiner for the Junior Cycle practical tests will be regarded as a contract of service. Examiners will be required to give their full time to the work over the period of appointment.
- 5. All examiners will be required to attend for the full duration of a training conference before the commencement of examining.
- 6. Appointment as examiner in any given year does not confer the right to appointment in subsequent years.
- 7. In line with the extension to the current Building Momentum public service agreement 2021-2022, the SEC will be applying the relevant increases to contract staff remuneration in 2023.
- 8. It is intended to issue practical examiner appointments as required during 2023.
- 9. In the appointment of Examiners/Monitors to project/practical coursework, preference will be given to those applicants who have also applied to mark written examination components.
- 10. All examiners are required to provide their mobile phone number and current email address as we may need to contact you prior to or during the marking process.
- 11. Travelling expenses and subsistence allowances will be paid in accordance with the regulations which apply to the public service. Further information will be available on the *Information for Contract Staff* Section of <u>www.examinations.ie</u>.
- 12. All payments on foot of this appointment will be made through an electronic money transfer system (i.e. Paypath). We will collect your bank details at a later stage. It is not possible to arrange payment other than to a bank account, therefore acceptance of payment to a bank account is a condition of employment.

- 13. If you fail to comply fully with the SEC's Instructions or if you act in a way which jeopardises the security or integrity of the examinations or if you act in a way which jeopardises the performance of the candidates, you are liable to be dismissed and you may also be refused any future appointment. If you are dismissed, you shall have no claim whatsoever against the SEC for remuneration or expenses.
- 14. Applicants should note that all applications will be considered fairly and impartially by the State Examinations Commission. Applicants giving incorrect information will be disqualified. Canvassing will lead to the application being disqualified.

 - (e) Teachers who are on Suspension/Administration Leave.

Junior Cycle Home Economics Practical Performance tests will take place from Monday 20th to Friday 31st March 2023 and from Monday17th to Friday 21st April 2023.

Junior Cycle Music Practical Performance Tests will take place from Monday 17th to Friday 28th April 2023.

Marking of Junior Cycle Practical Coursework

The Junior Cycle coursework in Visual Art, Engineering, Wood Technology, Applied Technology will be marked in schools in June and the marking conferences for these subjects will be held in May or early June depending on the subject.

CANDIDATE ACCESS TO ORAL/PRACTICAL MARKS - NEW FROM 2019

From 2019 onwards, the SEC will continue to provide examination candidates with access to their component marks, including oral and practical marks, following the issue of the provisional results and in advance of the Leaving and Junior Cycle appeals closing dates. The mark provided for each component will be the mark authorised by the Chief Examiner and credited to the candidate for the purpose of calculating the grade. (In certain subjects, the mark awarded by the examiner will have been subject to a process of moderation as part of the standardisation of examiners' work and/or the mark may have been subject to a weighting applied to that component as part of the grading process.) This information is being provided to candidates in the spirit of the Data Protection legislation which means that candidates can apply to the SEC for access to copies of all of their personal data including their examination scripts.
