Deputy Principal

This is a permanent position and the appointment will be made via open competition. Teachers who are fully registered with the Teaching Council Route 1 and have 5 years recognised teaching service, two of which must be in a recognised primary school within the Republic of Ireland may apply. This includes teachers who are on approved leave, such as sick leave, maternity leave, parent leave, parental leave, secondment or career break. The proposed starting date for this position is 14 November 2022.

The Deputy Principal will operate in partnership with the Principal to ensure the effective leadership and management of the school. The Deputy Principal may be required to deputise for the Principal in their absence, in all matters organisational/administrative and in relation to discipline within the school. The Deputy Principal must be willing to work in conjunction with/under the direction of the Principal.
